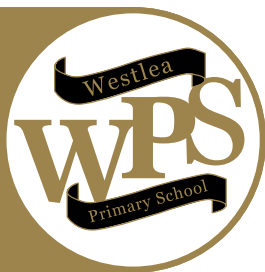

- ☐ Do a good deed in that benefits the community of Seaham



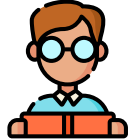
Ambition
